

WTW receives validation from the Science Based Targets initiative on our near-term and long-term net zero emissions reduction targets

LONDON, UK, November 28, 2024 — WTW (NASDAQ: WTW), a leading global advisory, broking, and solutions company is proud to announce that the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi) validated WTW's near-term and long-term emissions reduction targets. This significant milestone underscores WTW's commitment to sustainability and to reducing our carbon emissions.

The validated targets include a plan to reduce absolute scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 50%* by 2030 from a 2019 base year. Additionally, WTW has also set targets to engage 67% of suppliers by spend to set science-based targets by 2028 and reduce business travel emissions by 55% per full-time employee by 2030 from a 2019 base year. Looking further ahead, WTW has set a long-term target, approved by SBTi, to reach net-zero greenhouse gas emissions across the value chain by 2050.

The SBTi validation confirms that WTW's targets are aligned with the latest climate science and are sufficiently ambitious to meet the goals of the Paris Agreement. This commitment to scientifically validated targets demonstrates WTW's dedication to long term environmental stewardship in our own operations and through assisting others to act.
